

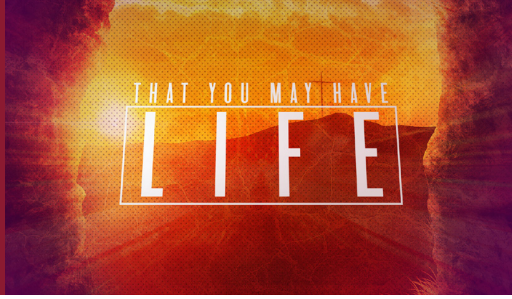

## STUDY QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: John 21:1-14

Opening: Read John 21:1-14. From the passage/sermon, what truths impacted you the most?

1. Reflect on this passage.

a. Why do you think Peter and the other six disciples went back to fishing?

b. How would you struggle in light of all that the disciples experienced?

c. In what area(s) of your life are you challenged to see and acknowledge Jesus and listen to His voice?

d. Where do you see God's provision and faithfulness in your life?

## STUDY QUESTIONS

2. Read Luke 5:1-11.

a. How are these stories similar?

b. What do you learn about God's character?

c. How can we react in similar ways to tough situations in our lives?

Application: Peter was working in his own strength and was failing, and then Jesus showed up. Think of an area of your life where you're trying to get things done on your own strength. How can you surrender this area to God? Take some time to confess any sin. Recognize God's character and that you need His help!
