b. Verse 15 says to “take care, and be on your guard...” What does this command mean and how can you put this into action?

3. What do the following Proverbs say about wisdom versus foolishness?

a. Proverbs 1:7

b. Proverbs 10:8

c. Proverbs 12:15

d. Proverbs 18:2

e. Proverbs 28:26

4. Where are you looking for satisfaction outside of Christ? Confess that to the Lord.
