Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/scripture?

1. Review the details of the Feast of Unleavened Bread. What is one thing you did not know?

2. Read 1 Corinthians 5:1-8:

a. What is happening in this passage? Why was Paul so upset with the Corinthians? (read 1Cor. 4 for more context)

b. How does our pride make us indifferent to sin (ours or someone else's)?

c. Do you ever compare yourself to other Christians when it comes to sin? Why is this dangerous?

d. What can we learn about accountability (or lack of) from this passage?

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

e. 2 Corinthians 5:17 says we are a new creation in Christ. How does this truth parallel verses 7-8?

f. Describe the imagery of leavened and unleavened bread. What is Paul referring to when he uses these terms?

g. Explain the significance that Christ's sacrifice has on our call to clean out the "old leaven".

h. How does the "old leaven" affect the Church? How does this new "unleavened" bread affect the Church? Give some examples.

3. How can you celebrate the Sinless One more intentionally in your daily life? What does it look like to celebrate Jesus' sacrifice on a personal level?

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to go after (i.e. remembering Him more, confession and submission, time with Him privately)?
