Intro: _____

1. Instructional: _____ that God has a plan for rallying us all together in honor of Him. (Lev 23:23-25)

2. Historical: _____ the God of mercy who gathered His people to repentance and praise. (Neh 8:1-8)

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/scripture?

1. Review the details of the Feast of Trumpets. What is one thing you did not know?

2. Read Psalm 89:8-17. This passage specifies character traits of God on which the elect should focus when they gather, as they do in the Feast of Trumpets. In fact, verse 15 even references the Feast of Trumpet in the phrase “festal shout” (or trumpet blast).

a. List several traits about God that stir you from verses 8-17. How does each of these traits impact your daily life?

b. From verse 15, what does it mean to “know the festal shout”? What “blessing” do you think may come with that?

c. How would you describe a person who “walks in the light of [His] face”?

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

d. Verse 16 says “[Blessed are those] who exult in Your name all the day.”
What does that mean?

e. In what ways can you grow in acknowledging God so that you will exult
in His name all the day?

3. From what you learned in the message and what you learned in Psalm 89, what
motivation do you see for being more intentional about celebrating the Gathering
One in your daily life?

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus
do you need to go after (i.e. celebrating His plan, hearing Him through His Word, and
worshiping Him)?
