2. Destroying One: Read Revelation 19:15 and 21, Zechariah 14:4-5 and 12, and Acts 1:9-12.

a. From where did Jesus ascend into heaven after His resurrection (Acts 1:9-12)?

b. What promise did the angels give (Acts 1:9-12)?

c. To where is He returning (Zechariah 14:4-5)? Where is that?

d. How does Zechariah 14:12 expound on what is being described in Revelation 19:15 and 21?

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

e. How does this blow your mind about God?

3. Restoring One: Read Hebrews 10:11-18.

a. Compare the role of the priest and the role of Jesus in verses 11-12 and 14. Why was Jesus able to sit down, but not the priests?

b. Compare Hebrews 10:13 with Philippians 2:10-11. How does this impact your view of Jesus' authority?

c. How does verse 18 impact your view of God's responsibility vs. your responsibility?

4. How do these passages impact your worship of the Restoring and Destroying One?

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to go after (i.e. celebrating His plan, remembering His forgiveness, worshiping Him in all of His power and authority)?
